We have sold all of our available tickets! I am very excited about the show. Look for more details closer to the trip in February.



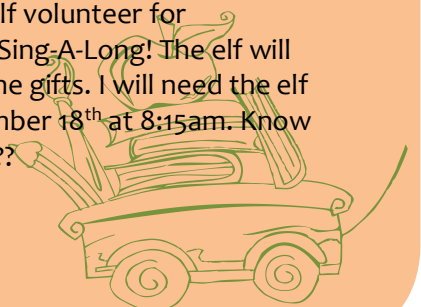
