DIRECTORS CORNER

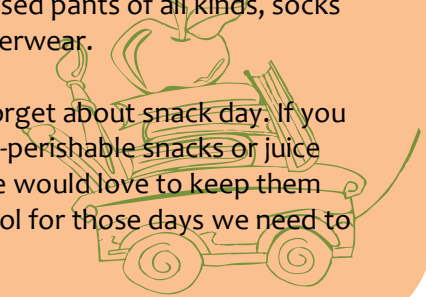
Registration is Right Around the Corner!
